#### October 14, 2021

Barb Manning called the business meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the largest group we have had since the Covid pandemic started. Gwen Jones made a motion to approve the September guild meeting minutes, seconded by Leslie Tidaback/Hilmer. M/C

Gwen Jones made a motion to approve the Treasurer report posted in the October newsletter, Marilyn Herrman seconded M/C.

Barb welcomed three visitors this evening.

Jane Rush reports Irene Pearson is having complications from a recent surgery. Everyone is encouraged to phone/send cards.

**Quilt Show** – Jane Rush is looking for volunteers to help with the Quilt Show committee. Jane has a signup sheet tonight. If you are interested please contact Jane for the 2022 show in mid July.

**Membership** -30 members signed up last month. Jane will be taking dues tonight.

Elections – Jane Rush is declining her nomination for president. Kay Craw made a motion to approve the following Executive Board slate of officers: President – Cathy Benke, Vice President - Nancy Hawley, Secretary – Lois Lentz, Treasurer – Julie Koch, Co-Treasurer – Bekki Lund. Seconded by Gwen Jones M/C.

Golden Thimble – Kathy Phipps, the current

Golden Thimble winner, introduced Cathy Benke, Marilyn Herrman and Jane Rush as this year's Golden Thimble nominations. Paper ballots were distributed and collected. The winner will be awarded at the November guild meeting.

**Library** - Marilyn Herrman presented several more books recently donated from the Laura Williams estate.

**Articles of Association** - Michelle Tuller and Maxine Wantuck introduced a change to the Articles of Association as posted in the October

newsletter. They report these Articles have not been reviewed for at least 3 years. They are proposing the following change to Article Two: Article Two - Organization and Purpose This non-profit guild is tax-exempt as a social welfare organization described in Internal Revenue Code (IRC) section 501(c)(4), as an organization that must not be organized for profit and must be operated exclusively to promote social welfare. The property of this organization is solely dedicated to the purpose of this article and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any officer, committee chairperson, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

The *specific* purpose *of this organization* shall be:

- To promote the appreciation and knowledge of fine quilts
- To sponsor and support quilting activities
- To encourage quilt making and collecting
- To contribute to the growth and knowledge of quilting techniques, textiles, patterns and history by providing educational meetings, travel and fellowship.

Several questions asked included: was the Board included in the input of this change; why such a long version stating we are a non-profit; has the committee reviewed all the Articles since there is a discrepancy between the Articles of Association and the Policies and Procedures. Written ballets were distributed while the questions were being asked. Maxine Wantuck and Sandy Scott counted the ballots and later in the evening reported "way over 2/3 of the votes were in favor". No count numbers were provided.

**Board Meeting** – the last Board meeting for the 2021 Board is scheduled for November 1, 6:00 PM at the New Buffalo Library. The committee chairs are requested to pass on information to next year's chairs at this meeting.

Motion was made by Sara Lawrick to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Bekki Lund. M/C

Raffle Baskets were won by Jan Sanders and Pearl Hedtke. We made \$56 tonight.
